### THESE CONDITIONS APPLY TO ALL CANDIDATES WHO SIT THIS EXAM.

- ◆ Applications to sit this exam should be received no later than 12<sup>th</sup> February, 2010. Applications received after this date will be subject to a \$10 late fee.
- ◆ You must sign and date the application form, certifying that you have read and will abide by the terms and conditions of the FAA Exam Booklet. This Booklet can be obtained free from the FAA web-site (<http://www.faainc.org.au/Exams/faaexam.htm>) or in hard copy from the Director at a cost of \$25.00.
- ◆ The cost of the exam is \$130.00, payable upon application. The attached application form should be signed and sent to the Director FAA Inc. Board of Examiners, 50A Cowper St, Byron Bay, NSW 2481.
- ◆ Completed Exam papers must be returned (Express Post preferred), post-marked no later than Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2010 to The Director, FAA Inc Board of Examiners, 50A Cowper St, Byron Bay, NSW 2481.
- ◆ It may take up to six weeks after returning your completed exam papers to the Director, to receive your results. Please make contact with the Director if results have not been received after that time.
- ◆ Your name must NOT appear on any of the papers that are submitted. You will be issued with a Candidate Number by the Director prior to the Examination commencing. This number is to be written on every page of assessment papers submitted to ensure the confidentiality of each candidate.
- ◆ TWO (2) COPIES of all your answers must be returned to the Director. Candidates are advised to keep a further copy for themselves.
- ◆ Each essay must comply with a word limit of 2,500 words, with a 10% variation accepted. Not only is the candidate assessed on their astrological knowledge, consideration is given to their ability to write a properly structured, succinct and academic work which may (with consent) later be published in the FAA Journal. The 2,500 word limit applies to the essay's Introduction, Body and Conclusion, this includes any footnotes, references or appendices. Any title page, charts, tables, and bibliography are not included in the word limit.
- ◆ Essays should be typed and double line spaced using a clear font of with a 12pt font size.
- ◆ Plagiarism will result in failure. All sources must be acknowledged. All material submitted will become the property of the FAA and no papers will be returned to candidates. However, copyright of all material remains with the author.
- ◆ All candidates must be current financial members of an FAA affiliated organisation.
- ◆ The Board of Examiner's decision with respect to results is final.
- ◆ Certificates for successful candidates will be forwarded to the relevant State Association for presentation.
- ◆ These conditions form part of the Application for this Exam.

### WITHDRAWALS AND CANCELLATIONS:

Cancellations received seven (7) days prior to the Exam being mailed out, will incur a \$20 withdrawal fee. The exam fee, minus the \$20 withdrawal fee, will be reimbursed within seven days of receipt of written notice of withdrawal.

If you withdraw from the exam once the exam papers have been despatched, all monies paid will be forfeited. (Please advise the Examination Board Director if you are withdrawing.)
