**Answer THREE questions only. Be sure to state your astrological reasoning throughout your answer.**

## Question 1.

### **Transits Only**

Petra was born at 1:25 pm on 10<sup>th</sup> March 1966 in Sydney. Her Ascendant is about 24 degrees Gemini. Her life has not been easy and she spent much time in her 20's and 30's involved in holistic psychotherapy. Even though her life is more emotionally stable and easier than it has been, she wants to know what is in store for her during 2005.

Produce a list or map of her transits for 2005 and rank them in order of importance. Interpret the five (5) most important transits of this year, in psychological depth. Take the natal configurations, such as house positions and rulerships, into account.

## Question 2.

### **Secondary Progressions Only**

Angela was born at 3:17 am, on the 27<sup>th</sup> February 1964 in Sydney, NSW. Her natal ascendant is close to 7 degrees Aquarius. She has recently had an operation to remove cancer and this has given her time and pause to review her life. She has worked for some time in the pressure of corporate life and wants to change this vocation to something less stressful.

Using just the technique of Secondary Progressions, explain where she now stands in her current Secondary Progressed Lunation cycle. What is the duration of this cycle, when does it start, and what could this mean? Explain the progressed change of Sign of her personal planets during her life, especially the Sun and Moon.

## Question 3.

### **Solar Arc Only**

Tony was born at 1:55 pm on 14<sup>th</sup> November 1977 in Sydney. His Ascendant is 11.5 degrees Pisces. He has been working as a solicitor for a few years but feels that he is going crazy in a nine to five job, five days a week. He is longing for a radical change of life style, but doesn't know what it looks like.

Doing just his Solar Arc planetary aspects for 2005, 2006 and 2007, offer him some future direction by interpreting the possibilities that show up.

## Question 4.

### **Solar Returns**

There is a Federal Election on the 9<sup>th</sup> of October 2004. You will probably know the results of this event by the time you do this question. However, as an exercise in the use of a Solar Return chart, use this technique to predict who will be the Prime Minister of Australia for the next three years.

With the result known, it's your astrological reasoning that is being tested here. Both the following people live in Sydney.

Mark Latham was born at 1:30 am, on the 28<sup>th</sup> of February 1961 in Sydney. 1:30 am is the time given by his office and independently verified by others.

John Howard was born on 26<sup>th</sup> July 1939 in Sydney. His birth time is unknown and both his parents are dead. A rectification by an astrologer produced a time of 4 am. Another astrologer claims that his mother said he was born at 2 am and then rectified the chart to 2:21 am. All in all, it's dirty data. How would you handle this uncertainty?

## Question 5.

### **Planetary Cycles.**

Carol is a client who wants to get a handle on the phases of her life, so that she doesn't live so much of the time in the dark and can understand her past more fully. During 2000 until late 2003, she just wanted to withdraw from her business and not have to deal with people.

Carol was born at 2 am on 28<sup>th</sup> December 1954 in Sydney. Her ascendant is close to 22 degrees Scorpio.

Using the technique of plotting just the **Secondary Progressed Moon through the Houses** of her birth chart, describe the outlines of her life journey from July 1976 until Nov 2003. This period is a cycle of the Progressed Moon from her Ascendant around the chart back to the Ascendant. Explain the sequences of life phases she has been through and help her to feel that she is on familiar ground. Include in your answer, reference to planets in houses and house ruler ship.
