# 2004 Interpretation Exam

## Section 1. Natal Interpretation

**Answer only TWO (2) questions in this section.**

**Be sure to state your Astrological reasoning throughout your answer.**

### **Question 1**

Matisse: born 12:05 pm, 8<sup>th</sup> January 2004. Nambour, Queensland.

Her Ascendant is close to 19 degrees Aries. Her mother knows a little about astrology and comes to you to interpret her daughter's birth chart. She wants to gain some insights into which archetypal energies are most emphasised in the chart. What will she have to deal with in being mother to this child? If she can see her child's inner routines, she may be less prone to guilt and better able to understand. What are the difficulties Matisse may face in life and what are her special abilities?

### **Question 2**

Annette: born 3:50 pm, 20<sup>th</sup> April 1967. Sutherland, NSW.

Her Ascendant is close to 24 degrees Virgo. Childless and not in a committed relationship, Annette comes to you to get a more objective picture of her relationship difficulties. She knows that she has impossible-to-fill expectations and doubts as to whether she will ever be good enough to meet anyone else's. She wants to understand the cause of her ongoing personal insecurity and the belief that marriage is a 'ball-and-chain' situation. Can she have a successful committed relationship or is her life to be found in other directions?

### **Question 3**

Eric: born 6:50 pm, 12<sup>th</sup> September 1946. Wanganui, New Zealand.

His Ascendant is close to 29 degrees Pisces. Eric has lived in Brisbane for the last 35 years, has had 3 children and is now divorced. Two of his children have a family of their own. He was recently hospitalised with a haemorrhage in the brain. Some of his cognitive faculties are still weak and he is facing an operation in March to remove blood clots and damaged blood vessels. This is a rather dark time in his life and he would value some direction and help in seeing future possibilities. He is not a naturally patient person and finds the inactivity and waiting onerous.

## Section 2. – Relationship Astrology

### **Question 1**

Kay and Luke have become romantically involved and now have to make some important decisions. Are they headed for matrimony, family, etc? Or is their relationship a non-cohabiting one based primarily on friendship? Using only the technique of chart comparison (synastry), explain to them how they interact archetypally with each other. Which interactions are supportive and which are likely to cause problems. How may these problems be best handled? Use the following birth data:

Kay: 4:55 am, 27<sup>th</sup> July, 1969. Sydney, Australia.

Luke: 2:45 pm, 9<sup>th</sup> July 1965. Sydney, Australia.

### **Question 2**

The Beatles were arguably one of the most successful popular music groups of the 20<sup>th</sup> Century. Use a multiple composite chart to explain their phenomenal success. Are there also indications, in such a chart, of the duration of their popularity and the causes of the group breaking up? What other astrological and non-astrological factors do you consider supported their popularity? Use the following birth data:

John Lennon: 6:30 pm BST, 9<sup>th</sup> October 1940. Liverpool, UK.

Paul McCartney: 2:00 pm, 18<sup>th</sup> June 1942. Liverpool, UK.

George Harrison: 11:42 pm BST, 24<sup>th</sup> February 1943. Liverpool, UK.

Ringo Starr: 00:05 am, 7<sup>th</sup> July 1940. Liverpool, UK.
