Answer only TWO (2) questions in this section.

Be sure to state your Astrological reasoning throughout your answer.

Question 1

Samantha: born 30 March 1984 at 10:35am Wollongong, NSW
Her Ascendant is approximately 4 degrees Gemini.

Samantha comes to you six months after breaking up with her boyfriend of 3 years. They have a young daughter who he sees spasmodically and this is creating difficulties. Her relationship with her own family has always been turbulent and she does not want to recreate this now. She admits to not being blameless in the current break up and would like a second chance. Using **the natal chart only**, discuss Samantha's relationship needs and how parental conditioning may affect this.

Question 2

Anne: born 26 Dec 1952 at 10:25pm Melbourne, Victoria
Her Ascendant is approximately 22 degrees Leo.

Ann travelled quite a lot when younger before settling down to a rewarding career in the film industry. Having children later in life she has always thrown herself into and been very supportive of their activities and schooling. Now they are in their mid teens they find her too controlling and demanding. Whilst she understands the natural rebelliousness of the age, she comes to you wanting some insight into her behaviour and how best to deal with the situation before things get out of hand.

Question 3

Sharnie: born 10 August 2003 at 1:45am Melbourne, Victoria
Her Ascendant is approximately 25 degrees Taurus

Julie comes to you wanting some insight into the basic nature of her 1 year old daughter Sharnie. She wants to know how best to foster any natural talents she may have. Julie herself has always tried to please her own mother but feels constantly rejected by her.

Question 1

Nigel: 30 June 1958 7:55am Sydney, NSW
His Ascendant is approximately 20 degrees Cancer
Suzette: 1 Sept 1961 11:45am Sydney, NSW
Her Ascendant is approximately 24 degrees Sagittarius

Nigel comes to you in quite an emotional state. His 12 year marriage is on the rocks and he is desperate to salvage it if possible. He feels he has sacrificed his own career by looking after their two children aged 8 and 10 years. Suzette travelled quite a bit, building up a successful business. Suzette did not want to participate in the consultation but was quite happy to supply her birth data. Using the Chart Comparison technique of **Synastry**, what would you advise Nigel so as he is able to gain a clearer perspective on their relationship dynamics and how they can be improved.

Question 2

Using any method of **Relationship Chart** (example Composite, Davison, Coalescent) and the same data as above (Q1) what would you advise Nigel of the strengths and weaknesses of his relationship with Suzette?
