


Section Two

Annie: Born on November 12, 1982, at 9:38 pm in Melbourne ASC  
Close to 9 Gemini.

Annie has come for career guidance. She already has a degree in Tourism and Events and has worked in a number of roles in hospitality and organizing events; however, she is looking to retrain in a career that has more family-friendly hours as she now has a partner and two young children. She is currently working part-time in a hospitality role at a conference centre. She is also looking for the intellectual stimulation offered through further study as she will have a bit of time on her hands when her youngest child starts school in 2021.

In the past, Annie has thought she may like to train as a primary school teacher but is now thinking that she would like a career as a psychologist after having gone through some challenges of her own and been helped by counselling.

Annie is wondering if the chart shows she may be better suited to one career or the other, or whether you can offer her some other ideas. How can you assist Annie in finding a more fulfilling career path?



## **Introduction**

Annie has come for guidance in having a fulfilling career path, therefore I will first have a general overview of the chart and look at the big 3 (Sun, Moon and Ascendant) to get a flair of the fundamental essence of this person. This will enable me to see how she expresses her power and her feelings. Then, I will look at the nodal axis to understand Annie's old patterns as well as what she needs to overcome in life. Finally, I will study in more detail the houses of substance and the two Yods configuration aspects involved. Upon completing this analysis, I will assist Annie with some insights into her career choices and vocational path.

### **General Overview.**

Annie has 7 planets in the Northern Hemisphere (below the horizon) which suggests she is an introvert, and she may have difficulty in relating to the outside world. As a result, she may enjoy working alone and her accomplishments may often be unrecognised. All the planets are clustered on the western hemisphere (on the right) of the Meridian which indicates she could be dependent on others and she would work best in partnership or group employment. The majority of the planets are distributed in the 2nd quadrant (4th, 5th and 6th house). This usually indicates the person will be oriented towards their immediate environment. The preponderance of planets in the 6<sup>th</sup> house suggests Annie will be oriented toward her professional environment with a special emphasis on work. Annie could be a specialist in her field. The natal chart takes the shape of a bundle which reflects the narrowness of experience and vision. This implies that Annie may have a tendency to channel all her energy into topics that relate to the houses occupied by planets in her chart (Mainly 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> house). Annie is lacking earth which implies a possible lack of practicality. There is a water dominance which denotes a person who is sensitive, intuitive and imaginative.

### **The Big 3, The Sun, Moon and Ascendant.**

Annie was born with a Sun in Scorpio. Scorpio is a strong sign and people born under its influence have strong will power. They have an intense emotional drive, and they are private. Whatever they accomplished is done with passion and completeness. The Sun is in the 6th house, the house of everyday work. This placement indicates Annie may place intense focus on everyday work and everyday routine. The ruler of the 6<sup>th</sup> house Scorpio is Pluto which is in the 5<sup>th</sup> house. Annie needs to have a work routine (Sun 6th house) and interact with attributes

of the 5th house which are creativity, personal self-expression and interacting with children (Pluto ruler of the 6<sup>th</sup> in the 5<sup>th</sup> house).

Annie's rising sign is in Gemini, a sign of communication. This placement suggests Annie could have a facility to connect with people and particularly children. (Ascendant Gemini are talkative, funny and youthful.) The ruler of the sign on the Ascendant is said to rule the chart. The planet rising before the Sun is the Oriental planet which provides a general view of life, an orientation. Mercury is both the personal ruler and the Oriental planet. Annie may have a strong orientation towards communications. The chart ruler reveals in which house of the zodiac Annie may spend much of her time and the oriental planet indicates which qualities this person has to offer. Mercury is in the 5th house, on the cusp of the 6th house conjunct the Sun. Mercury (Gemini rising) indicates the need to express ideas and communicate information to others. In the 5th house, it indicates that her self-expression may be oriented toward pleasure, creativity, and children. Mercury on the cusps of the 6th house indicates the importance of working and being of service to others. Being able to communicate is vital for Annie (Mercury conjunct Sun). The mind of Mercury in the water sign Scorpio has the skills of a detective - highly sensitive and intuitive. Mercury suggests she could have high emotional intelligence and she may have the need to communicate at a deep emotional level.

The Moon is the most important object after the Sun. It shows where Annie's major interest in life is, as well as how she is expressing her feelings. The placement of the Moon shows what provides a sense of security to an individual. In this chart, the energy of the Moon is strong and expresses its energy with ease since it is in accidental dignity (Moon 4th house). Her close family, the people she lives with, as well as the support and care from her parents, could represent what makes her feel safe and strong. The Moon suggests Annie may need to be blissful. She may need balance and harmony (Moon Libra) in her domestic environment (4th house) in order to feel well, happy and joyful. The Moon is in Libra in the 4th house. Nevertheless, the 4th house cusp intersects in Virgo. The foundation of who Annie (4th

House), is oriented toward her daily work (Mercury ruler Virgo in the 6th house). She may have the tendency to be a perfectionist and she could get a strong sense of satisfaction (Moon in 4<sup>th</sup> house) for a job well done (Mercury ruler Virgo in the 6th house). Venus, the ruler of Libra is in the 6th house. Venus is the planet of Love in the house of work. When love prospers, so does work. In order to be grounded, Annie may need to do something she is passionate about, on a day-to-day basis. Note that Jupiter is conjunct to Mercury, Sun and Venus forming a stellium. This concentration of energy equips Annie with a sharp mind and a desire for knowledge. Jupiter amplifies her ability to use her resources wisely and it may help Annie fulfil her goals in life. Furthermore, this concentration of energy suggests she could have a quite determined approach towards her life and career and could excel in her areas of interests. She could be writing material for her work (Mercury Chart Ruler + Oriental planet on the cusp of the 6<sup>th</sup> house) and get recognition for it. (Saturn supports Mercury. Saturn is the planet before the oriental planet in Libra.)

## **The Nodes of the Moon.**

The South Node, which the ancients called the dragon's tail, indicates old patterns, the comfort zone, and the "primary" needs a person tries to satisfy. The South Node indicates the pattern a person keeps returning to. The person may have the tendency to remain comfortable with old habits and retreat from a greater challenge. Understanding somebody's South Node indicates what the person needs to overcome in life. Once the person realises where they are and what needs to be resolved, then, the person can look to the opposite end, where the head of the dragon gives them direction. The North Node reveals where to go, and new actions that should be integrated in order to fulfil our existence. This is why the North Node illuminates our spiritual path.

## **North Node Cancer 1st House / South Node Capricorn 7th House. The Axis of Strength and Fragility.**

With a South Node in Capricorn, this person may long for authority and respect in the society.

She may be sensitive to public opinion and may want to give a good impression to the world (South Node in Capricorn). She might want to show people she is a serious and responsible person. She could be fearful of being judged and this could lead her to carefully hide her feelings. As a result, people might see her as someone who is reserved. This situation may create a distance between herself and the others which could lead her to solitude.

The North Node in Cancer is asking her to shed the coldness of the Capricorn. It is an invitation to get in touch with her nurturing side and show people how sensitive she is. From a career perspective, the north Node is asking her to express her personality, be more spontaneous, less conventional and pursue her ambitions without worrying about what will be said. There are no reasons to be afraid of showing her weaknesses. Following the spiritual path of the North Node could become a springboard for a nurturing vocation. Without getting too deep into the lunar phase, it is interesting to observe that she was born with a Balsamic Moon. This phase is the last one of a cycle which encourages the individual to canvass new patterns.

### **The Houses of Substance – 2<sup>nd</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Houses.**

Following the analysis of the nodal axis, the qualities of Cancer are important for Annie's personal development and evolution. She is being asked to develop the traits of nurturing, mothering and care for others (North Node in Cancer). Cancer is on the cusp of the 2<sup>nd</sup> house. The house of money and possessions, personal freedom, and resources in general that provides physical safety and assurance. Annie could gain security (2<sup>nd</sup> house) through family, homeland, traditions and culture (2<sup>nd</sup> house cusp in Cancer). Annie might have the ability to make a living by nurturing or caring for others. The idea of working as a primary school teacher is confirmed once again. Since we are in the realm of Cancer and Libra (Ruler of Cancer is the Moon in Libra), areas of interest could be history, literature, gastronomy, preservation of regional tradition and culture. Moon squares Mars in Capricorn in the 7<sup>th</sup> house. Mars is exalted in Capricorn. This denotes that success and education may be important for Annie. She could have a strong drive to achieve her goals. This square could make Annie be seen as courageous, aggressive, persistent as well as intolerant with lazy people around her. She could be overly ambitious, responsible, and willing to work hard.

Scorpio is on the cusp of the 6th house. Annie might be passionately involved in her everyday work. Currently, she might feel she has a vast reservoir of talent. Even though she may be working hard to achieve her goals, she might feel she has another special calling in life. She may have the urge to fulfil an unknown purpose without being able to figure out exactly what that is. If we look closely at her chart, her powerful stellium in Scorpio is the activation point of a Yod.

**Yod aspect pattern - Chiron inconjunct to Pluto-Saturn and Neptune.**

The ruler of Annie's Sun sign is Pluto, which is tightly conjunct to Saturn. These are two powerful planets that have affected a whole generation. This contact between Pluto and Saturn carries strong energy which can be difficult to handle. Annie may have the tendency to be exposed to the theme of power, control and authority issues. She may have had to respond to a frightening situation that could have harmed her physical, emotional or psychological strength. Alternatively, she may have experienced a life-threatening situation that forced her to face her fears and confront death or survival instincts. Without discussing particular situations, these experiences have taught her a life lesson at an early age.

Neptune also has had a generational influence. Neptune sextile Saturn-Pluto, indicates Annie belongs to a generation that can bring about social changes. She could use her inspiration to be of service to humanity and help others work on improving social conditions.

Chiron points out where the person is suffering the most. It also shows where the person has an opportunity to rise above the pain and help others. Annie has Chiron in the 12th house.

This placement indicates she could have strong psychic abilities and yet she may have a loss of faith in the universe or she simply she does not doesn't believe in her psychic aptitudes.

The chart is inviting her to accept these abilities, develop them and be comfortable with them.

Chiron in Taurus indicates she could have a wound around values and resources. It could be that growing up, she did not get enough of something and she may feel undernourished (financially, emotionally, or spiritually). In her subconscious, this could have been translated as: "I am not worthy". She may have self-confidence issues that motivate her to work relentlessly toward her goals, as a way to compensate for this problem.

This Yod has great potential for transformation. It suggests Annie understands how it feels to be powerless in difficult situations (Saturn-Pluto). The base of the Yod suggests she would have been able to deal with her fears and trust issues to a point that she could now become an inspiration to others and help them do the same. Her four planets stellium is the activation point of the Yod. By diving into her own life experience and complexes she might have the ability to show others how to dive into theirs with compassion (Neptune) and give them a great potential for transformation (Saturn-Pluto) through healing (Chiron).

**Yod aspect pattern - Pluto-Saturn inconjunct to Chiron and the Midheaven (MC).**

Pisces is on the cusp of the 10th house, the house of higher achievement, career, and reputation. Annie could be known as someone who transcends people's lives. The MC is involved with another Yod. The base of the Yod is the MC sextile Chiron. This indicates she could be using her pain (Chiron) in her career (MC). She could be a counsellor, a therapist or a writer (Mercury is the Ruler of her chart and communication is vital to her) to heal others from past wounds. The Apex of the yod is Pluto-Saturn. Her ability to deal with her fear and trust issues (Saturn-Pluto) could allow her to experience professional success (MC) through her ability to relate to others (Ruler of the 10th is Neptune in the 7th).

## **Conclusion**

After analysing Annie's chart, she could be suited to both careers' paths.

She could be a primary school teacher or a psychologist to help people. To some extent, these two professions are interconnected. A teacher has a significant role to play in shaping the personality of their students. Teachers need to build rapport with them. Active listening, empathy, confidentiality are skills the teacher needs to make their students feel comfortable which encourage them to open up and blossom. Thus teachers are also counsellors.

The chart has indicated that Annie is devoted to her work and career. She has the urge to communicate, learn and she long for authority and respect in society.

Being creative at work or working with children daily could provide Annie with a healthy and happy routine. A teacher's education is ongoing. As a teacher, Annie could continue to take classes and workshops to enhance her skills, which would also stimulate her intellect (stellium in Scorpio in the 6<sup>th</sup> house). Being a teacher would allow her to share knowledge of a topic she is passionate about (Venus in Scorpio). While allowing her to do something creative, enjoyable and meaningful (Moon in Libra – Venus in the 6<sup>th</sup>). As a teacher, Annie would be the manager of her classroom (Sun in Scorpio - need for control). She could connect and communicate (Ascendant Gemini) working as a teacher (Jupiter) and being of service (Mercury cusp 6<sup>th</sup> house) to children (5<sup>th</sup> house) everyday (Sun 6<sup>th</sup> house), through subjects that would give purpose, open children mind, transform their soul and empower them for life (Sun-Mercury Scorpio). She could research a subject she likes (Mercury and Venus in Scorpio) and creatively use her communication skills, as well as write manuals, in order to transmit that knowledge gained (Mercury 5<sup>th</sup> house, Mercury personal ruler + oriental planet).

Finally, working as a teacher, Annie would be able to spend time with her family and children.

She would not have to work on weekends or summers holiday. This would help her balance work with other aspects of her life and she would have more family-friendly hours (Moon 4th house in Libra).

On the other hand, If and when Annie chooses to become a counsellor or a psychologist she could connect and communicate at a deep emotional level with people (Mercury in Scorpio). She would go where the fingers of God (the 2 Yods in her Chart) are pointing. Annie could follow a career as a psychologist to guide and help children and enable people to purge agonizing experiences and heal from their trauma. By helping them, she would also learn that the best way to gain control in the world is to let go of control. Moreover, She could rely on her nurturing instincts (Moon in 4<sup>th</sup> house) as well as her highly sensitive and intuitive nature (SunMercury Scorpio) to address problems she has been facing herself. Thus, she would understand that self-worth comes from within and not from how much she has in her bank account. This journey would happily link the dots to her Nodal Axis story as it would allow her to nurture, protect and transform people (North node in Cancer).
